**An Archaistic carved Jade Vase with handle and cover**

Qing Dynasty, Qianlong period (1736-95)

The flattened pear shaped body decorated with a band of bosses within a band of taotie motive at the bottom and a band of ruyi and kui dragon at the top, all raised on an oval foot. To one side a climbing tiger carved in high relief forms the handle. The cover decorated with a band of taotie masks with two crescent moons as the finial. The stone of an even white colour.
